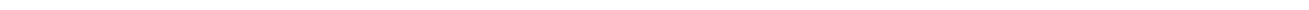

5B	Face moisturizer products applied to the face using the hands, primarily leave-on	Applicable, leave-on
5C	Hand cream products applied to the hands using the hands, primarily leave-on	Applicable, leave-on
5D	Baby creams, baby oils and baby talc	Applicable, leave-on
6	Products with oral and lip exposure	Applicable, rinse-off
7A	Rinse-off products applied to the hair with some hand contact	Applicable, rinse-off
7B	Leave-on products applied to the hair with some hand contact	Applicable, leave-on
8	Products with significant anogenital exposure	Applicable, leave-on
9	Products with body and hand exposure, primarily rinse-off	Applicable, rinse-off
10A	Household care excluding aerosol/spray products	Applicable, rinse-off
